IT WAS VERY WHITE UNDERNEATH (ESPECIALLY EVIDENT IN FLIGHT) AND GRAY ABOVE. SCALY APPEARANCE OF BACK NOT NOTICED AT TIME OF OBSERVATION, DARK LEGS.
