Ereast and Sides: Pale greenish-yellow.

Belly and Flanks: Yellow, paler than upper breast.

Undertail Coverts: Nearly white but tinged with yellow.

Back: Plain grayish-green.

Wings: Dark grayish-brown, no wing-bars.

Underwings: ?

Rump: Same as back, gray-green.

Uppertail Coverts: Brownish-green.

Upper Side of Tail: Dark gray-brown, light edges.

Under Side of Tail: Light " "

Shape of Tail: Notched vireo-type.

Voice: Not heard.

Behavior: No information.

Habitat: Brushy ravine, willow, hawthorn, etc.
