COLOR CONTINUOUSLY FROM THROAT

TO THE UNDERTAIL COVERTS, INCLUDING

FLANKS AND SIDES. THE COLOR WAS UNBROKEN.

ACROSS BREAST AND NOT DWINDED CONFINED

TO THE SIDES AND FLANKS.

FACIAL PATIERN: THE SUPERCILARY WAS
WHITISH ABOVE A DARKEY EYE. THE EYE-LINE
WAS BLACK AND MERCONT OF EYE TO JUST
BEHIND IT. THE EYELINE WAS VERY
PRONOUNCED IN THE LORAL REGION,
APPEARING AS A LORAL SPOT. NO EYERWS.

BILL COLOR APPEADED TOBE HORN. THE BILL WAS STOUTER THAN A WARBLER BUT SLIGHTER THAN THAT OF A SOLITARY VIRED OR RED-BYED VIRED.

NO CALL OR SONG HEARD.

NO PRIOR EXPORTANCE WITH THIS SPECIES. OF THE
