A warbler w/ bright yellowish underparts and forehead and crown. Nape and back more of a greenish-yellow. Wings were a dull blue-gray with two rather narrow but still very distinct white wingbars. Solid, medium-width black line through eye. Tail showed much white on underside of outer tail feathers when bird in flight.)
