Observation Comments:	<div>   </div> <p>The bird was moving about silently in a ditch beneath cottonwood trees. Hermit thrush and gray-cheeked thrush were considered as possibilities for identification. One of the three photos shows some color contrast between the tail and body, suggestive of a hermit thrush, but lighting in the shade appears to be uneven and misleading. Instead, the faint, incomplete eyeing and the slender nature of the bird suggest it is a gray-cheeked thrush.</p>
